- potentially libellous, false, or defamatory statements

- language and material which is offensive, extreme, or provocative. This not only includes obvious swear words and insults, but any language to which people reading it could reasonably take offence
- hate speech, threatening, or pornographic; incites violence; or contains nudity or graphic or gratuitous violence.
- Any personal details such as your telephone number, address etc
